The Calder Action Group Inc will be holding a public meeting on the 7th of October 2010, at 4:30pm, at the BP Service station southbound opposite the Thunderdome, address 1262 Calder Fwy, Calder Park.

The purpose of this meeting is that our group seeks a formal and urgent commitment from both sides of government, Labor and Liberal, for the future planning and development of the Calder Freeway/Calder Park Drive interchange.

This request is in accordance with previous correspondence and our publicized mission statement of the 7th of June 2007.
